DESCRIPTIONS

Construction

Construction:

Carvel mahogany tight seam planking, bronze-screw fastened to white oak frames and white oak/utile backbone. Varnished mahogany cabin trunk and coaming, and varnished locust toerails and handrails. Mahogany sub-deck with plywood/Dynel and Awlgrip paint overlay. Self-bailing cockpit is 6'x 8', and the seat lockers have been modified to open down to the bilge for greater accessibility and storage. Teak seats and sole; tiller steering to keel hung rudder; 8,800 lbs. outside iron ballast. White topsides with red boottop and green bottom; Off White decks.

Sleeps 4 in standard Concordia layout. Stowage righ forward followed by two pipe berths and additional stowage in the forward cabin. The enclosed head is next aft to port with WC; holding tank; and stowage lockers, and additional lockers opposite to starboard. Next aft is the traditional Concordia layout with settees/Concordia berths port and starboard and a dropleaf locust table with inset "telltale" compass between. The Concordia heating stove is on the head bulkhead forward and the stack is in the head compartment so that the head is heated as well. The galley is aft with icebox and stainless sink to port, and gimbaled kerosene stove with small oven and additional stowage to starboard. Traditional Concordia finish below with white paint overhead; varnished bulkheads and trim; teak sole and traditional Concordia corduroy cushion covers.

Sails and Rigging

Masthead yawl rig with SS standing rigging to bronze turnbuckles; bronze hardware; custom mainsheet traveler with bronze traveler block. Varnished Sitka spruce masts, booms and spinnaker pole. Self tailing Bronze primary and bronze secondary winches in cockpit. Sails include dacron main, mizzen and roller furling genoa which are all by Doyle in 2008.












LOCATION MAP
